**Project title:** Arts in the Classroom

**Purpose & Scope: DRAWING:** The four basic fundamental skills, how to compress light into six values and technique needed to start a good drawing will be the focus:

HAPCO Music Foundation has a series called “Arts in the Classroom” in which HAPCO matches art professionals with youth in all grade levels to all art forms. Our goal is to give our youth the tools and skills needed to use the arts as a vehicle for education or as a profession. We match art professionals with youth community programs and or classroom settings and the professionals conduct an educational symposium to meet our goals of increasing access to the arts and the knowledge of the art form presented. It is an effective, hands-on learning method for youth to learn from professionals in art fields including music, visual arts, theatre, writing and dance.

In **DRAWING**, the youth will be immersed in:

1. The schema
2. Separating the shadow and light shapes.
3. Filling in and refining the shapes.
4. Edges (hard, sharp, lost or found).
5. Six values:
  - A. Cast shadow
  - B. Core shadow
  - C. Half/Mid tones
  - D. Reflected light
  - E. Light area
  - F. Highlight.
6. The construction and layout.
7. Breaking up the larger shapes into smaller shapes.
8. Filling in the shapes and keying the drawing.
9. Creating the light impression and big form modeling.
10. The final project
11. Preparing all works for the showcase.

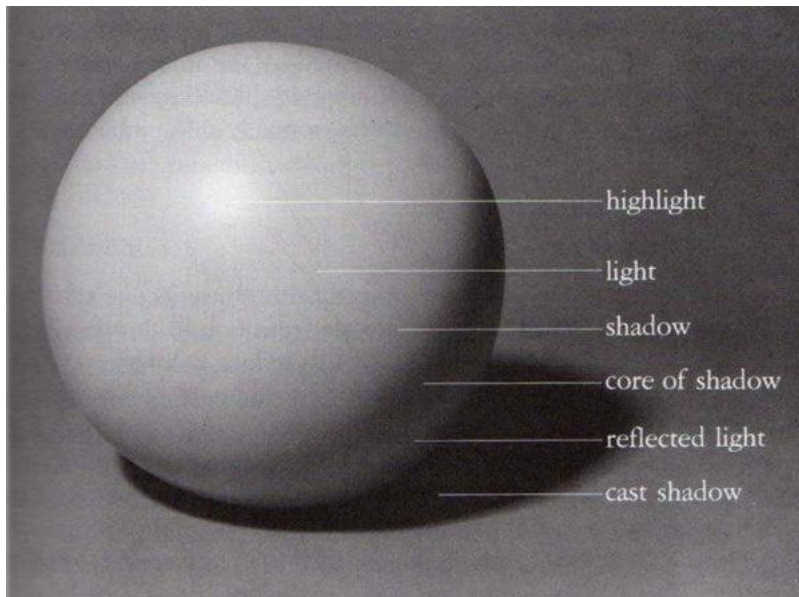

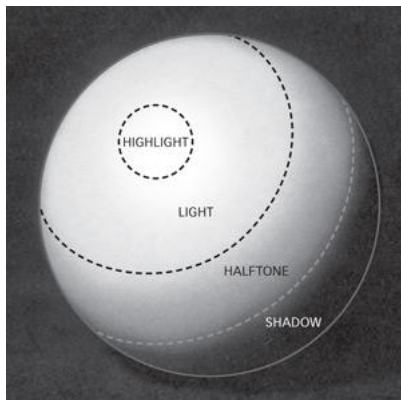

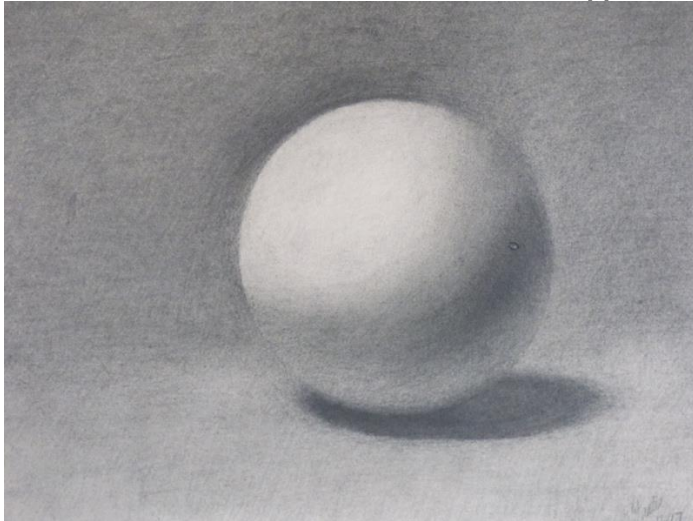
